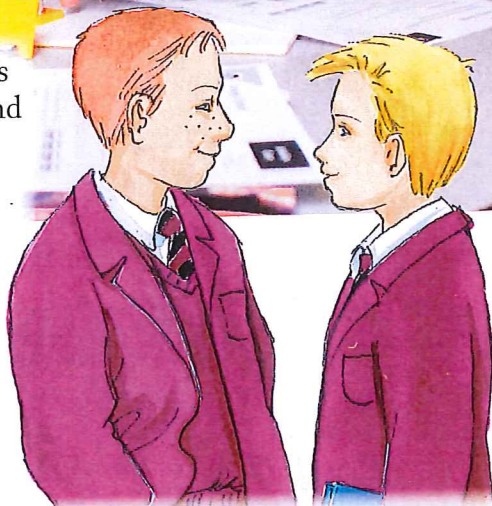


# How do you get to school?
